



Job Title: Nurse Practitioner
Classification: Full Time/ Exempt
Reports to: Medical Director

Summary: Provide direct primary medical care to patients of the Coastal Bend Wellness Foundation, under the supervision of the Medical Director.

Responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive medical care to patients of all ages, including making appropriate referrals for substance abuse and behavioral health needs as needed.
- Work on a mobile clinic site, providing care in rural communities, as well as in the main clinic.
- Work with HIV positive people to provide HV treatment in conjunction with primary health care.
- Assesses patient health by interviewing patients; performing physical examinations; obtaining, updating, and studying medical histories.
- Determines abnormal conditions by administering or ordering diagnostic tests, such as x-rays, electrocardiograms, and laboratory studies; interpreting test results.
- Documents patient care services by charting in patient and department records.
- Performs therapeutic procedures by administering injections and immunizations; suturing; managing wounds and infections.
- Instructs and counsels patients by describing therapeutic regimens; giving normal growth and development information; discussing family planning; providing counseling on emotional problems of daily living; promoting wellness and health maintenance.
- Provides continuity of care by developing and implementing patient management plans.
- Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules and regulations.
- Protects patients and employees by adhering to infection control policies and protocols.
- Complies with federal, state, and local legal and professional requirements by studying existing and new legislation; anticipating future legislation; enforcing adherence to requirements; advising management of needed actions.
- Maintains professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications; establishing personal networks; participating in professional societies. Contributes to team effort by accomplishing related results as needed.

Additional Expectations:

- Provider is willing to be trained in the treatment and management of HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis through the various professional resources available to CBWF.
- Provider will possibly work on Mobile Clinic 4 days a week providing care in the surrounding rural areas.
- Provider will agree to provide necessary Supervision of Mid-Level staff as directed and defined by the Texas Board of Medical Examiners.

- Provider will work with other Clinicians to meet or exceed the number of New Patient Encounters and Established Patient Encounters defined in FQHC Notice of Award.
- Provider is expected to arrive on time to schedule clinic location ready to see patients.

Qualifications/Experience:

- Candidate must be a licensed to practice an APRN in Texas with no pending or previous disciplinary action from any state licensing entity.
- Preferred experience in working in a FQHC or similar health center.

Time/Physical Requirements

- Monday-Friday, 8:30am-5:30pm/40 hours per week.
- Some evening and weekend activities may require flexing schedule
- Tasks occur in both medical office and clinic setting
- Able to lift 25lbs and perform normal duties associated in a clinic and office setting.
